




Returning to Campus: A Quick Guide

Here's a high-level look at how we plan to safely resume on-campus learning and working during the COVID-19 pandemic.

CAMPUSES WILL RE-OPEN IN FOUR PHASES

Our phased-in approach follows guidelines and public health measures in the Province of Manitoba's Restoring Safe Services Plan, and reflects the specific needs of our programs and services.

Visit rrc.ca/coronavirus/return-to-campus to see which programs and departments will be returning to campus within each phase. Throughout each phase, the number of students and employees on campus will be very limited as the majority of people will continue to learn and work remotely.

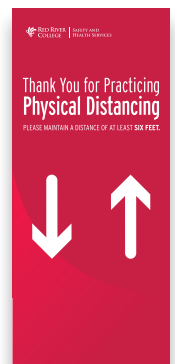
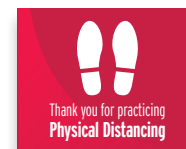
Please note: Occupancy percentages are a guideline of how many people we are permitted to have on campus, and do not necessarily reflect campus population at any given time. Many students and employees will continue to learn virtually and work remotely throughout all phases.

PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS

- Stay home if you are sick or feeling unwell.
