The President provided the Board with an overview of the six-month consultative process used to develop RRC's 2012/13 budget. The budget parameters approved by the Board in January 2012 provided the framework for achieving a balanced budget.

3. BUDGET - 2012/13 APPROVAL (CONTINUED)

That Board was informed that allocation decisions for the upcoming year were guided by the themes of the College's Strategic Plan:

- Fuel Manitoba Growth and Community Development
- Lead Aboriginal Achievement
- Strengthen Student Achievement
- Improve RRC's Triple Bottom Line: People/Planet/Profits

Board members reviewed the draft 2012/13 RRC operating budget. The Board was also provided with the Paterson GlobalFoods Institute budget for information.

MOTION B 12/06/01

That the Draft 2012/13 Operating Budget dated June 13, 2012 be approved as presented. – CARRIED

That Board considered a proposal to increase a student technology fee that contributes to the College's IT infrastructure. The demands placed on the existing infrastructure have dramatically increased and enhancements are required to continue to meet students' expectations regarding available technology, internet access and connectivity. It was also noted that RRC's student technology fee is significantly lower than other post-secondary institutes within Manitoba and across Canada.
