5.1 <u>President's Report</u>

The President advised Board members regarding the implementation of the provincial government's 15% Public Sector Management Reduction that occurred at RRC the previous week. He also discussed two property matters with the Board.

5.2 <u>Students' Association President's Report</u>

Board member L. Slegers informed Board members of recent career building initiatives organized by the RRCSA, including the Annual Career Fair that attracted over 1,200 students each day. She also attended one of MNP's risk identification workshops to provide feedback for their Enterprise Risk Management project for RRC.

5.3 Employee Member's Report

Board member A. Warren reported that College Council met on January 17, 2018 and has a standing agenda item to identify things around the College that could be improved upon. Council members are also thinking of hosting tables where staff can drop by to share their thoughts about RRC's activities.

5.4 Vice-Presidents' Reports

Finance and Administration

The Vice-President, Finance and Administration informed the Board that an RFP is being issued for a new human resources system and the Enterprise Risk Management project is going well. She also mentioned a student was hired by the IT Department for a pilot project and it was so successful the department is looking at having students as regular members of their team.

Academic

The Vice-President, Academic advised Board members regarding training that RRC is providing in northern communities. She mentioned the Animal Health Technology Program received a two-year certification, RRC is hosting this year's Canadian Deaf Games for volleyball and basketball, and Graphic Design and Photography students will be hosting sales of their art.
