The Senior Network Analyst is responsible for the establishment, maintenance, stability, and security of the College network environment. This includes researching, planning, documenting, and managing projects for network upgrades and deployment of new networking products and technologies; monitoring network performance and analyzing network logs; acting as a key resource for troubleshooting and resolving any network hardware, software, or connectivity problems; liaising with key stakeholders regarding network technology questions or projects; and providing indirect supervision, guidance, and assistance in the allocation of day to day tasks for Network Technicians.
