DUTIES

RRC Polytech requires an instructor in the Community Services Department. The successful candidate will instruct in the Child and Youth Care Program. The Child and Youth Care Program provides graduates with the skills and knowledge to work with children and youth experiencing behavioral and emotional difficulties. Instructor responsibilities include classroom instruction, curriculum development, as well as practicum supervision.

- A degree in Child and Youth Care or related fields; an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- Extensive experience working with at risk and vulnerable children and youth
- A thorough knowledge and understanding about the specific role of Child and Youth Care practitioners in the support of Indigenous, newcomer and refugee children, youth, and families
- Demonstrated leadership skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Effective presentation skills with ability to present material to diverse groups with the use of appropriate technology
- Ability to work in a collaborative environment as well as independently
- Experience with Microsoft Office Software
