DUTIES

The role of the Indigenous Liaison Advisor is to increase the participation rates of Indigenous students at RRC Polytech, build new relationships amongst First Nation, Inuit, and Metis communities and organizations while maintaining existing relationships. The position acts as a first point of contact for Indigenous students/community members. The position will host in-person and virtual meetings, as well as phone conversations to offer program guidance and to facilitate personal and professional relationships with students, funders, families, principals, etc. In-person visits to remote and Northern Indigenous communities is required.

- College diploma in a related field of study; an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- Experience with Indigenous post-secondary transitional and academic achievement challenges, planning, and assessment
- Indigenous Ancestry
- Experience with and practice of Indigenous culture, history, knowledge systems, and Indigenous community relationship building practices and protocols
- Knowledge of RRC Polytech's academic programs and location, as well as student services offered
- Knowledge of advising and guiding students on their academic progress
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Strong conflict resolution skills
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Experience in public speaking and presentations
- Values Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- Commitment to lifelong learning
