DUTIES

The Centre for Learning and Program Excellence (CLPE) at Red River College is building an eligibility list for Instructional Design term positions. Successful candidates will support the development of blended and online courses and educational resources for academic programming at RRC. The position will apply modern learning theory and instructional design principles to identify appropriate instructional strategies towards building engaging courses and learning content. Incumbents will develop expertise in Red River College's learning management system (Brightspace by D2L) to provide guidance to faculty in using the platform and to develop online course content. Duties include supporting subject matters in course development, consultation and faculty development in instructional design, learning strategies, assessment and evaluation, and technology.

- Post-graduate education in the field of Education, Instructional Design, or a related subject. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- Substantial experience in course development and design in an online or blended learning environment
- Strong knowledge of adult learning theory and its application
