DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of Applied Commerce and Management Education, the Instructor will be responsible to teach Marketing related courses which may be delivered online and/or in-class at either the Notre Dame Campus or the Exchange District Campus. Duties will include the preparation of course materials and examinations, instruction of students and evaluation of course materials. Courses may include, but are not limited to Marketing Foundations, Consumer Behavior, Integrated Marketing Communications, Professional Selling, Marketing Research, Digital Marketing 1 & 2, International Marketing, Service Marketing, Event Marketing and Management, Project Management and Marketing Strategy. Duties related to instructing include: curriculum development and maintenance, preparing course outlines, maintaining student records, student evaluation, assisting in college activities including student orientation, graduation, and relevant committees.
