DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of Creative Arts, a full-time instructor is required to teach Media Production in Creative Arts. Drawing upon extensive experience, Instructors will be expected to lead dynamic, engaging blended instruction to students using LEARN and Microsoft Teams, among others. Exceptional technical expertise paired with strong communication skills are required to inspire students. Ideal candidates will have expertise in cinematography, lighting, and camera work for documentary and narrative film. The candidate will also need to be capable of teaching editing. It would be an asset to have expertise in other areas of filmmaking, such as writing, directing, producing, colour grading, or sound design.
