DUTIES

Red River College, Portage Campus requires a classroom instructor for teaching, supervision and guidance of students in both classroom and practicum settings. This will include: preparing course outlines, maintaining student records, student evaluation, development and adherence to the delivery schedule within an allocated time, attendance at scheduled meetings, ensuring curriculum content is consistent with parent program, and student assignments reflect industry needs. Courses to be filled may include but are not limited to Careers in Food Manufacturing; Workplace Safety; Introduction to Quality and Compliance; Manufacturing Tools and Equipment; and Math for Manufacturing and Personal Finance.
