Construction Trades

Applicants are to clearly demonstrate how they satisfy the selection criteria in their written submissions and must identify the competition number they are applying for in the subject line of the email.

This competition may be used to establish a 12 month eligibility list of qualified candidates for future vacancies.

DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of Construction Trades, the Instructor is required to deliver both the theoretical and practical aspects of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning to apprentices and pre-employment students in the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Technical program, including instruction into related trades. Topics include, but are not limited to: trade safety, tools and equipment, gas fitting, electrical theory, refrigeration system design, installation and commissioning and servicing, blueprint reading and code. Duties include, but are not limited to: development, delivery and modification of curriculum, conduction of student assessment, performing lab and classroom facility design and setup, maintaining lab and classroom equipment and performing related administrative responsibilities as required.

- Valid inter-provincial journeyman's certificate in Refrigeration, Air Conditioning and Domestic Gasfitter B
- Significant related industry experience in the commercial and/or residential aspects of the trade
- Experience using a variety of hand tools and machines, related to the trade
- Experience interpreting drawings and specifications
- Effective verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to work independently as well as in small to large group settings
- Excellent interpersonal, leadership and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to present material to diverse groups with the use of appropriate technology
- Proficiency with MS Office software (Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint)
