DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of Applied Computer Education, the Instructor(s) will teach both online and on-campus courses for Applied Computer Education programs. Courses cover topics such as software application development, web development, DevOps, user experience, and cloud computing. Duties will include teaching existing courses, collaborating to develop and update courses, and engaging students to create meaningful applied learning opportunities. Successful candidates will also contribute to the learning environment of the department by committing to ongoing professional development to stay current with industry practices, supporting the learning of peers, and participating in departmental and College projects and committees. Solid technical expertise paired with strong communication and intercultural skills are required to inspire students in a blended learning environment.
