DUTIES

RRC Polytech's School of Hospitality and Culinary Arts (Paterson GlobalFoods Institute) requires experienced dish & pot washing personnel who can also assist in basic food preparation and kitchen duties. These roles are responsible for maintaining high-quality customer satisfaction and professional representation in PGI's food service areas. During all aspects of food service, it would be expected that all safety and health precautions are taken. Demonstration of attention to detail will result in all crockery, small wares, and guest areas remaining clean and organized; and that all the equipment is both used and maintained properly and in a safe manner. These roles show initiative by ensuring all food service areas are stocked and ready. All support personnel are required to interact positively with the student population. This is a casual term position.
