DUTIES

The instructor(s) are required to teach a variety of courses in their field for Red River College Polytechnic, Regional Campuses for Business related programs delivered in Winkler. Duties include but are not limited to: maintaining student records, classroom management, student evaluation, marking and grade submission, preparing course outlines and curriculum development. The Instructors teach both online and in-person. The subject areas include Accounting, Business Law, Logistics & Supply Chain, Marketing, HR, and Management.

Note that classes are scheduled from 8am to 8 pm, Monday through Friday.
