DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair, the Instructors are required to facilitate clinical practice to students in the Bachelor of Nursing Program; conduct student assessment and counselling; utilize the course LEARN website; effectively manage clinical practice student groups; and perform related administrative responsibilities as required.

- Currently licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN) in Manitoba or eligible for registration as an RN in Manitoba
- Bachelor of Nursing Degree; Diploma combined with relevant work experience
- Several years of recent clinical practice experience working in one or more of the following areas: Medicine; Surgery; Pediatrics; Obstetrics; Community; Gerontology; Mental Health; Palliative Care
- Ability to carry out formative and summative assessments
- Ability to manage conflict and exercise good judgment
- Effective leadership skills
- Effective interpersonal and communication skills
- Proficient in the use of Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook)
- Experience building a respectful workplace culture that promotes diversity, learning and continuous improvement
